

SEVERE WEATHER POLICY & PROCEDURES

If your event has been cancelled due to poor weather conditions, please consult with management to inquire about a 'raincheck' for your admission fees.

WHAT IS 'INCLEMENT WEATHER'?

Inclement weather can be severe weather conditions ranging from heavy rain or winds, to severe heat. Before arriving for your event, it is recommended that you check the local weather reports for news and information regarding the weather for that day.

If for any reason weather conditions are actively deteriorating, Daytona Beach Zipline Adventure reserve the right to close and post-pone any current admissions, for the safety of our staff and customers.

Weather conditions are constantly changing and in the event weather conditions become dangerous then facility staff will make an announcement that all participants must exit the course and return to the main building.

WHAT YOU CAN DO BEFORE YOUR EVENT:

- 1. Call before arriving for your event to check on weather conditions at the park
- 2. If you are concerned that weather conditions will interfere with your event, we can help
- 3. Do your research; check the local weather reports 2-3 days prior to your event

PROCEDURES FOR SUDDEN WEATHER CHANGES:

- 1. Facility staff will monitor the weather conditions before and during your event to ensure that you have a positive & safe experience
- 2. If the weather conditions deteriorate to an unsafe level, then all participants will be requested to exit the course and move to a safe area
- 3. Facility staff and management will ensure that all loose equipment is secured and all participants are relocated safely
